## ASM Knowledge Hub Board

The ASM Knowledge Hub Board will be chaired by the Ministry of Mining and Heavy Industry (MMHI). The ASM Knowledge Hub Board will be the primary decision-making body for the ASM Knowledge Hub. It will represent the ASM Knowledge Hub externally and will provide advisory guidance, strategic thinking and recommendations for the sustainability of the ASM Knowledge Hub beyond the implementation.

- define a strategic plan and business cases of the ASM Knowledge Hub
- provide the ASM Knowledge Hub Secretariat with guidance and advice on developing and monitoring the ASM Knowledge Hub strategy and on developing a sustainable business model of the ASM Knowledge Hub activity.
- prepare appropriate documents and policies to support the development of the ASM Knowledge Hub
- monitor and review the relevance and value of its work and the Terms of Reference till end of the phase
- ensure quality assurance and accountability of the ASM Knowledge Hub, including the communications, marketing and fundraising strategy

The Board will hold meetings every quarter to provide guidance on key issues, such as the ASM Knowledge Hub's policies, budgetary control, annual plan, resource allocation, and monitoring and evaluation of progress. Additionally, the chair and other ASM Knowledge Hub Board members will be available at other times for consultations with the ASM Knowledge Hub Secretariat.

### **KH Board structure**

The Board will have 7 members representing the organizations who will commit to the sustainability of the Knowledge Hub. Members should be a balanced mix of different stakeholders from government organisations, ASMs, NGOs, civil society and donors/international organisations. Board members will be selected based on following qualifications, knowledge and interest on ASM.

- Have an ability to generate knowledge and information on ASM
- Have an interest in ASM
- Have a knowledge of and experience in communications, marketing, advocacy and fundraising
